ITT 35.4 reads "tenderers shall be allowed to quote separate prices for different lots (contracts) and the methodology to determine the lowest tenderer.	Bidders to note that whenever there is a conflict of the clauses in the Instructions to Tenderers (ITT) and the provisions in the data sheet, the clauses in the Data sheet will prevail over the Instructions to Tenderers (ITT). Prospective bidders are hereby advised that Data sheet ITT 1.1 prevails over ITT 35.4.
	2. Section III - evaluation and qualifications criteria; 4. Multiple Contacts on page 32 of 202 ii). "If a tenderer wins more than one Lot, the tenderer will be awarded contracts for all won lots" However Section II tenderer date sheet ITT 1.1 contradicts the above by station that "bidders are required to strictly quote for ONLY ONE LOT" and that "Bidders to note that bidding for more than one lot will lead to Automatic disqualification " Kindly clarify on this matter if a tenderer is allowed to quote for more than one lot within a single tender and if one can win and	This is to therefore advise that bidders are required to strictly quote for ONLY ONE LOT ." 		Bidders are also advised that their total cost must be inclusive of the Capacity Building Levy as follows:
		The tenderers are hereby notified of PPRA circular No. 01/2024 dated 30th August, 2024 and Legal notice No. 206 of 6th November, 2023 which introduces a Capacity Building Levy to be paid/borne by a supplier on all procurement contracts signed between the supplier and the procuring entity at a rate of 0.03% of the value of contract exclusive of applicable taxes. The procuring entity shall deduct and remit the levy to PPRA.
