SECTION VII- PRICE SCHEDULE did not indicate bid currency, we hope it is possible to quote in USD as per the bond requirements	Bidders can quote in any currency which is easily convertible to Kenya shillings. KRA shall apply mean Central Bank of Kenya (CBK) rates at the date of tender closing for comparison purposes.
3.	Special conditions of contract as relates to the GCC. We noticed inconsistence in numbering i.e. 3.6, 3.7, 3.8, 3.9, and then it goes to 3.14, 3.15, 3.16, 3.17 omitted, and 3.18. We hope that is order	Under SCC it has been emphasized on the clauses stated. Special Conditions of Contract shall supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, between the GCC and the SCC, the provisions of the SCC herein shall prevail over these in the GCC and therefore the order stays as is.
4.	The requirements in RFP cannot be full fulfilled by a DAM solution. Can we propose the various solutions that meet the defined technical requirements?	Provide the best solution that can meet our minimum technical requirements.
5.	Please assist us with the following information on the Data Base Audit Tool Tender in order to enable us respond to the request for proposal effectively; Serial no, source database to be audited, total number of individual users of the databases to be audited, number of CPU cores on the server hosting the database to be audited, hardware type for the server hosting the database to be audited e.g. Intel, sparc	These information shall be provided during contract implementation stage. However, the tool should be database platform independent.
