1.	<p>In Section 8.2 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS, page nr 22 of the RFP point 10 mentions: "Consultants must provide a written confirmation from Oracle that they are an approved Oracle university partner or education centre. In the case of a consortium or a joint venture, at least one member of the team must meet this requirement."</p> <p>Our Consortium will include an approved Oracle university partner / education center who will also carry the relevant certificate.</p> <p>However, as such organisations in Kenya are fewer than the companies that plan to submit responses to the subject RFP it will be a case of such organisations appearing as partners in more than one consortium/Joint Venture. We would like the contracting Authority to confirm that this will not lead to disqualification of the Joint Ventures/Consortia that collaborate with the same Oracle university partner / education centre to cover this requirement</p>	<p>KRA understands that the scope may necessitate a collaboration of different firms. An Oracle University partner appearing as a partner in more than one consortium/Joint Venture will not lead to the disqualification of the Joint Ventures/Consortia</p>
