


STEP BY STEP GUIDE FOR APPLICATION OF OVERPAYMENT ADJUSTMENT VOUCHER (OAV)

1. Introduction

The Tax Procedures Act was amended through the Finance Act 2022, to provide for refunds for overpaid tax for all taxes. iTax was enhanced in 2023 to allow taxpayers to apply for the offset of overpaid taxes through the OAV functionality. However, in August 2025, the offset of OAV **excluded** PAYE and withholding taxes, i.e., VAT withholding, Income Tax withholding, and withholding rent.

2. Timelines for application of OAV


- (i) In the case of income tax and excise duty obligations within five years from the date on which the tax was overpaid, effective from 1st July 2017.
 (ii) In the case of any other tax, within twelve months from the date on which the tax was overpaid.
- 3. Steps to follow
- i) Log onto the iTax profile with your PIN and password
- ii) Go to the 'Refunds' menu, select 'Refund or offset Overpaid Tax'




iii) Click on >>Refund or offset Overpaid Tax>> select the option for offset of overpaid tax >>Click Next







iv) System will auto-populate the basic information details, i.e. taxpayer PIN and Name. Click on the claim details and select the tax obligation that has overpaid taxes. iTax system will populate the Tax periods with overpayment qualifying for OAV.




v) Enter remarks in the 'remarks' section and attach the relevant supporting documents, select the tax period for the offset of overpaid tax, and then click on generate voucher.





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
- vi) In the past, clicking "generate voucher" would instantly create an overpayment voucher. However, the iTax system has been enhanced to include a workflow for overpayment adjustment vouchers. With this change, the application must undergo verification and approval by authorized KRA officers at the relevant Tax Service Office.
- vii) Upon approval, the system will generate an OAV that can be used to offset existing or future liabilities for all obligations except PAYE and Withholding Taxes (WHIT, WHRENT and WHVAT). Where the applied overpayment amount needs to be adjusted, the officer shall reject the task and initiate an additional assessment, data correction, or request that the taxpayer amend the return before reapplying with the correct amounts.
- viii) Once the OAV has been generated, offset against existing or future liabilities will be as follows through the taxpayer profile;
 - ❖ For existing liabilities, go to the payments menu, select Set off advance payment/Offset overpayment, select Overpayments/Refund adjustment voucher, and capture the offset voucher number. Select the obligations with liabilities, period, edit the amount where applicable, click add, and submit the application.







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- ❖ For future liabilities, the taxpayer must file the respective return first before offsetting the OAV against the liability as per the steps above.
- ❖ For instalment tax, the OAV will be offset during the payment slip generation process. In case the available OAV amount is less than the instalment tax payable, the taxpayer should first generate a PRN equal to the OAV amount before generating another PRN with the instalment tax payable balance and make payments as per the available options through mobile money, credit cards or KRA Agent Banks.
