NOTIFICATION OF INTENDED DISPOSAL OF OVERSTAYED GOODS AT INLAND CONTAINER DEPOT (ICD) - NAIROBI BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CUSTOMS AND BORDER CONTROL OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA

LEGAL NOTICE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred under Section 42(1) of the East African Community Customs Management Act, 2004 (*as amended*), notice is hereby given by the Commissioner of Customs and Border Control, Kenya Revenue Authority, to the owners of goods and the general public, that unless the goods specified and listed on the Kenya Revenue Authority website per the *web link below* are lawfully entered and removed from the custody of the Customs Warehouse Keeper (**INLAND CONTAINER DEPOT (ICD) - NAIROBI**) within thirty (30) days from the date of this notice, the said goods shall be deemed to have been abandoned to Customs and will be disposed in accordance with the provisions of the East African Community Customs Management Act, 2004.
