

ISSUANCE OF LICENCE FOR VEHICLES/VESSELS

CONVEYING TRANSIT GOODS - C.28

Introduction:

C28 is a License issued for a Vehicle/Vessel carrying transit goods. The requirements and special conditions are stipulated under East African Community Customs Management Regulation 104(5). The Customs and Border Control Department is mandated to issue Licenses for Vehicles/Vessels carrying Customs goods.

Procedure:

1. The applicant shall make an application to the Commissioner in the application form for Transit vehicle Licence.
2. The applicant shall notify the Transit Monitoring Unit (TMU) for inspection of the vehicle/vessel.
3. Upon inspection, TMU complete section B of the application form for Transit vehicle Licence.
4. The application should enclose the following requisite documents:
 - Copy of valid insurance certificate.
 - Copy of PIN
 - Copy of motor vehicle logbook (present original or certified copy of the log book during inspection)
5. Upon fulfillment of all the requirements and approval by the commissioner, a payment authorization slip (Form F147) will be issued for payment of licence fee of two hundred dollars (USD 200).
6. Licence will be issued upon verification of the payment.
