



GENERAL NOTICE

FRAUDULENT KRA STAFF IMPERSONATORS

Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) wishes to inform the public of a recent rise in incidents involving individuals impersonating KRA staff in an attempt to fraudulently solicit money from unsuspecting taxpayers and suppliers. In several recent cases, the fraudsters have contacted members of the public while falsely claiming to be officers from KRA's Supply Chain Management Division and promising to facilitate or influence procurement opportunities in exchange for money or other favours.

KRA wishes to categorically state that all its procurement processes are conducted in strict adherence to the law and are guided by the principles of fairness, transparency, competitiveness, and value for money. The Authority's procurement activities are governed by the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 (PPADA), which provides for open, transparent, and non-discriminatory procurement procedures. All evaluations and awards are undertaken through established legal and institutional frameworks, and no individual officer can influence or guarantee the award of tenders outside these procedures.
